Members & Players Code of Conduct

All players within the confines of the playing facilities concerned shall act in a responsible manner, and obey the instructions of the designated match officials, without question or delay. Captains representing Hexton Cricket Club will do so within the spirit of the game, according to the rules of cricket.

Cases of misconduct reported by the Umpires, Hexton Captains or Committee Members should be reported to the Committee. Acts of Gamesmanship, Abuse of Umpires, Abuse of Club Officials and acting in an unsporting manner will all be considered by the executive. In the event that the person or persons be found culpable for any action as specified then the executive have the power to bring about the following penalty or actions:

1. Take no action.
2. Warn the individual to his future conduct.
3. Withdraw the Individual's playing rights (for all teams) for a specific period.
4. Cancel the individuals membership.

The following are guidelines and as so are considered to be "Not acceptable"

1. Leaving the confines of the Ground without informing the Captain
2. Leaving the field of play without notifying the Umpires.
3. Leaving the field of play before the batsmen unless authorised.
4. Entering the field of play before the umpires.
5. Wearing clothing not deemed to be fit dress.
6. Failing to arrive at the appointed time, without authorisation.
7. Failing to pay club fees or membership.
